

DEPARTMENT 105 — GOATS

Judging: Wednesday at 9:00 AM

RULES:

- Age definitions:
 - A kid is one born between January 1 and March 31 of the exhibit year.
 - A yearling is one born between July 1 and December 31 of the year preceding the exhibit year and is less than 24 months of age. (The above animals shall never have freshened)
 - A milking yearling is under 2 years of age.
 - A doe is 2 years and over. Does which are 24 months of age or older and have never freshened may not be shown. (The does must have freshened, including dry milkers.)
- Goats with horns are permitted in all classes except Class A—Dairy Goats
- Goats will not be separated into breed classes. All breeds and crossbreeds will be exhibited by age groups.
- The following vaccinations and/or tests are recommended for exhibitor protection: Negative Brucellosis Test; Negative Tuberculosis Test; Shots for Shipping Fever and Leptospirosis; and use of a regular worming program.
- Mohair goats will be judged on basis of 60% fleece and 40% breed type.

- Broilers are young chickens, either sex, weighing between 2 1/2 and 4 1/2 pounds at 7-9 weeks of age.

DEPARTMENT 113 — CATS

Judging: Thursday at 10:00 AM

RULES:

1. All cats are required to have a distemper vaccination (triple shot would be best) certificate dated during current calendar year. Present certificate to Department Superintendent on judging day.
2. Not more than two cats may be brought to the fair by one exhibitor. One entry per item number.
3. Kittens are 4-8 months of age. Adults are over 8 months of age.
4. Long Hair: Hair coat more than one inch in length. Short Hair: Hair coat one inch or less in length.
5. No adult, whole males to be shown. No visibly pregnant females permitted.
6. Cats must be kept on leash or in pet carrier at all times while on fairgrounds.
7. Entry tags **MUST** be picked up during open class entry times.
