Judging: Wednesday at 9:00 AM (Breeds) and Showmanship to follow

RULES:

- Members are to list the breed of rabbit on their entry blank.
- Each exhibitor must wear their entry number when rabbits are shown.
- If exhibitors cannot be present, they must contact the superintendent to make arrangements.
- Rabbits incorrectly entered by sex or variety are disqualified.
- See animal health requirements.
- If at any time an animal shows evidence of contagious or infectious disease, it shall be removed from the exhibit as per the direction of the supervising veterinarian. Animals can only be removed from premises under permit from the Department of Agriculture or supervising veterinarian.
- Rabbits that are uncontrollable when being handled, not accustomed to being caged, or not tame, will not be admitted for exhibition.
- See 4-H Rabbit Guide for division of commercial and Fancy Breeds available at the UW Extension Office.
- All age and weight specifications as used by the American Rabbit Breeders Association will be strictly adhered to.
- Grade levels for showmanship classes determined as of January 1 off current calendar year.

- Registration required on Entry Blank.
- Danish Judging.
- Exhibitor must exhibit own animal.
- Grade levels for showmanship classes determined as of January 1 of current calendar year.

- Meat pen class consists of 3 rabbits. All of the same breed and variety. No rabbit over 69 days old or over 5 lbs. No rabbit may be entered in any other class.
- Single fryer is one rabbit not over 69 days old or over 5 lbs.; may not be entered in any other class.
- Roaster rabbit is one rabbit, either sex, between 70-180 days of age and over 5 pounds in weight; may not be entered in any other class.
