

MOTORIZED VEHICLE OPERATION POLICY

The safety of all patrons is of the utmost importance to the Fair Board and is the driving force behind this policy.

Only the following persons listed below will be allowed to drive a motorized vehicle on the fairgrounds:

- 1) Fair board members (significant other)
- 2) WCSO
- 3) Vendors
- 4) Carnival employees
- 5) First Aid/Fire Department Personnel
- 6) Motorized vehicles for the handicapped
- 7) County park employees

Vendors and carnival employees will not be allowed to drive on the grounds after 10 a.m. Only licensed drivers will be allowed to drive. Drivers must provide proof of insurance. Drivers must remain sober and operate their vehicle at a safe and prudent speed. Any erratic operation of vehicle may lead to operator being asked to remove their vehicle from the fairgrounds.

Mini bikes are forbidden.

Skateboards, roller blades, roller skates, and bicycles are also forbidden
